

ORIENTATION FOR DISCIPLESHIP PROGRAM 2023-2024

Welcome to the Discipleship Program for the academic year 2023-2024! We are excited to embark on this journey of spiritual growth together. Here are some key points for orientation:

Mandatory Reading Material:

- Discipleship Essentials: A Guide to Building Your Life in Christ" is a required book for each student.
- It is essential that every student possesses an individual copy of the book.
- Sharing books is strictly prohibited.
- Ensure that the book is brand new, with no prior use or markings from any previous owner. Each student's copy should be entirely blank and unused.

Scheduled Meeting Time:

- Formation of Small Groups:
- Students have the flexibility to create their own small groups, comprising a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 5 individuals for the discipleship class.
- Assistance is available for those who need help forming a group.
- Small groups are organized based on gender.

Group Leadership Structure:

- Each small group is required to designate a student leader.
- Additionally, a teacher will be assigned to each small group.

Required Assignments - Book, Test, Report:

A. Book:

- Students are expected to complete the Core Truth & Memory Verse Study Guide sections for each chapter before the class session.
- The classroom discussion will cover the remaining two sections, namely the Inductive Bible Study Guide and the Reading sections for the same chapter.
- All assigned work must be completed by the current students.

B. Test:

- At the conclusion of each unit, students will undergo a unit test. Each unit consists of 6-7 chapters, depending on the specific unit.
- Review questions will be provided to aid in preparation.

C. Report:

- Each unit spans 6-7 weeks, during which students will report on their personal quiet time for two weeks.
- The teacher will assign the specific two weeks for each student.
- The report should include the duration of the quiet time and the Bible section read, presented in the following format:
- Example: Quiet time 20 minutes & John 1:1-18

Attendance Policy:

- Regular attendance is mandatory unless there is an emergency or advance notice is provided by a parent or guardian.
- Failure to maintain consistent attendance may result in the removal of students from the discipleship class.

Events:

- A concluding event will be scheduled at the end of each unit, taking place on a Saturday.
